Project Spotlight

This featured project, located in Naperville, was a complete overhaul of the existing back patio area. The scope of the project was to include a built-in barbecue, small lounge area, main dining area, fire pit area, stoop, seatwalls, piers and water feature. The water feature consists of two waterfalls situated in an elevated planter that empty into a narrow trough of water below. The installation of this water feature proved to be quite challenging with multiple structural walls, water-proofing, water supply and electrical work. The materials used are Unilock Brussels Block, Unilock Olde Quarry and natural bluestone for the barbecue countertop, waterfall ledges, water trough liner and patio inlay. The barbecue features an outdoor refrigerator and built-in warming drawer.
